\* All students please enter through the south auditorium entrance to begin Trojan Photo Day.

\* Upon entering the doors, students will be able to purchase a student LHS activity event pass -\$60.00- Family Pass-\$150.00. The family pass includes the student and allows immediate family members into all home games, excluding state and district playoffs. This ID must be shown at every home event for entry.

Ø Purchase of an activity/event card is optional; therefore if a student does not want a student activity event pass they will proceed to have their picture taken. Student activity pass must be purchased before their ID picture is taken so that it can be printed on their ID.

Ø If you are purchasing pictures you can go to the Studio 5 website and either download the order form or pre-pay online. If you wish to pay during Trojan Photo Day, please print out the completed order form and submit along with appropriate form of payment (cash or check). If paying by check, please make payable to Studio 5.

\* All students are required to have their pictures taken for ID purposes. ID's are a necessary form of identification and the first ID is free. ID's are used for, entrance into building, library book checkout and attending school related events (dances, plays, and sporting events). Students may be denied admission into school related activities without their current ID. In addition, students are required to produce identification when requested by administration or staff and should carry with them at all times while on school grounds.

• We ask that all students dress appropriately in accordance to the school dress code for ID pictures. Hats will not be allowed in the photos. Students wearing revealing or inappropriate attire will not have a picture taken and will not receive their class schedule.

\* After students receive their ID's, they will continue the registration process. Lockers and parking permits will be available to students. LHS does not accept credit cards and ask that students bring separate checks (payable to Longmont High School) or cash.

• Only students with their new 2017-2018 student ID may pick up their schedule:

**New Student Registration** (Only students new to SVVSD): Tuesday, August 1st at 6:30 p.m. in the LHS Commons. Please enter through main entrance off of Sunset. (Please bring birth certificate, immunization records, proof of residency, transcripts and any school records.

**Schedule Corrections (wrong placement only):** Schedule changes for **grade 9 only** will take place on August 8th from 8:00 a.m. to 12 noon in the Community Room.

**Schedule Corrections for grades 10-12** will be by appointment only on August 9th and 10th and will be scheduled at Trojan Photo Day. Schedule corrections will only be allowed if there has been an error in placement.
