



Pathways in Technology Early College High School (P-TECH) is a new type of school that brings together the best elements of high school, college, and the professional world.

Offered at Longmont High, this P-TECH program allows students to earn a high school diploma, as well as a no-cost Associate of Arts degree focusing on business from Front Range Community College. This program includes significant mentorship and internship opportunities with our industry partners: City of Longmont, Longmont Chamber of Commerce, Longmont Downtown Development Authority, and Longmont Economic Development Partnership. This program gives students a head start on their careers after completing the program. Students enroll in 9th grade and complete the program in 4-6 years.

Longmont High's P-TECH will focus on a business pathway, providing a foundation for careers in many growing industries, as well as entrepreneurship.



P-TECH students will be allowed to matriculate through the 14th grade.



Students in P-TECH will graduate with a high school diploma and an Associate of Arts degree from Front Range Community College.



P-TECH students will also receive mentorship and internship opportunities with the City of Longmont, Longmont Chamber of Commerce, Longmont Downtown Development Authority, and Longmont Economic Development Partnership.

EARN A NO-COST ASSOCIATE DEGREE FOCUSING ON BUSINESS

Starting in 2023 at Longmont High School, working with Front Range Community College, the City of Longmont, Longmont Chamber of Commerce, Longmont Downtown Development Authority, and Longmont Economic Development Partnership, SVVSD will offer students the opportunity to graduate with a high school diploma and Associate of Arts degree in Business in 4-6 years.

In the Longmont High School business P-TECH pathway, the district will support concurrent enrollment during grades 9-12. Students can receive dual credit from St. Vrain and Front Range.

Along with college courses, students will receive mentorships and internships through the City of Longmont, Longmont Chamber of Commerce, Longmont Downtown Development Authority, and Longmont Economic Development Partnership to provide real-world experiences to supplement their academic coursework.

Students must apply for the P-TECH program and will begin coursework in the 9th grade.
