MyAp Process

- Longmont and your middle school counselors can assist students with the MyAp process

Freshmen Core Subjects-What you may see recommended

- **English:** Language Arts 9 or Honors Language Arts 9
- **Math:** Algebra 1, Accelerated Algebra, Honors Geometry, Honors Algebra 2
- **Science:** Biology or Honors Biology
- **Social Studies:** World Geography, Honors World Geography, or AP Human Geography

Freshmen Elective Options-What you get to choose.

- **Health:** All freshmen will be enrolled in this class
- **Art, Business, Computer Science, Drama, Engineering, Music, PE:** Check prerequisites for each class
- **World Languages:** Chinese 1 or 2, French 1, Spanish 1 or 2, or Spanish for Spanish Speakers

Freshmen Special Programming

- **MBSA:** Students will be placed in Introduction to Healthcare
- **H SOB:** Students will be placed in Leadership or Wealth Management
- **SPED, ELL, Literacy:** Students will be placed in appropriate classes
