

## Longmont High AP Diploma Requirements\*



1. Students must take **five year-long AP courses (or the equivalent)**. AP courses: Art, Music, Computer Science, Mathematics, Science, Social Studies, Language Arts, and World Languages.
2. Students must complete their five AP courses with **no grade lower than a B**.
3. Students **must take 5 AP exams** in each AP course that counts as a subject area requirement by the end of their senior year.
4. Students must **submit an application** (link) for the Longmont High School AP Diploma in the year in which they intend to graduate **by April 1**.

## National Recognition through College Board\*

|                             |  |
|-----------------------------|--|
| AP Scholar                  | Granted to students who receive scores of 3 or higher on three or more AP Exams.   |
| AP Scholar with Honor       | Granted to students who receive an average score of at least 3.25 on all AP Exams taken, and scores of 3 or higher on four or more of these exams. |
| AP Scholar with Distinction | Granted to students who receive an average score of at least 3.5 on all AP Exams taken, and scores of 3 or higher on five or more of these exams.  |

## AP Capstone Diploma/AP Seminar and Research Certificate\*

Students who earn scores of 3 or higher in AP Seminar **and** AP Research **and** on four additional AP Exams of their choosing receive the **AP Capstone Diploma™**.

Students who earn scores of 3 or higher in AP Seminar **and** AP Research **but not** on four additional AP Exams receive the **AP Seminar and Research Certificate**.

\*Seniors who have not received exam scores at the time of graduation will be considered candidates in all award areas.
